Bill Tracking:

- <u>Nevada Legislature Personalized Legislative Tracking (PLT)</u>: PLT allows you to subscribe to BDRs, bills, and budgets that are of interest to you and subsequently tag and create notes. You will also receive immediate notifications of hearings, a daily status notification, and have access to tailored, exportable reports for the subscriptions you have chosen to track. The service is free.
- <u>Children's Bill Tracking List</u>: Nevada Institute for Children's Research and Policy Tracking list of bills related to children's health, education, safety, economic well-being and other categories.
- <u>Children's Advocacy Alliance Bill and Bill Draft Request Tracking</u>: Tracking list of bills related to children's school readiness, health, safety and economic well-being.
- <u>Nevada Legislature Calendar of Meetings</u>: Daily Schedule of Legislative Committee Meetings and Floor Sessions

Who is My Legislator and How Do I Contact Them?:

- <u>Who is my Legislator and what district do I live in:</u> Find out your Senate and Assembly Districts as well as who your representatives are.
- <u>Contact your Senator</u> : Contact information for your State Senator.
- <u>Contact your Assemblyperson</u>: Contact information for you State Assemblyperson.
