### Bill Tracking & Policy Priorities:

- [Nevada Legislature Personalized Legislative Tracking \(PLT\)](#): PLT is a free service that allows you to subscribe to BDRs, bills, and budgets that are of interest to you and subsequently tag and create notes. You will also receive immediate notifications of hearings, a daily status notification, and have access to tailored, exportable reports.
- [LegiScan](#): LegiScan is another service that allows you to track the status of bills.
- [Children's Bill Tracking List](#): Nevada Institute for Children's Research and Policy Tracking list of bills related to children's health, education, safety, economic well-being and other categories.
