10% of high school students nationwide (1.56 million) reported currently using e-cigarettes.

39.7% of high school students nationwide who currently use e-cigarettes reported using them on **20 or more** of the past **30 days**. **4.6%** of middle school students nationwide (550,000) reported currently using e-cigarettes.

20.7% of middle school students nationwide who currently use e-cigarettes reported using them on **20 or more of the past 30 days.**



15.1% of high school students in Nevada reported currently using e-cigarettes.

13.7% use cannabis.3.4% use smokeless tobacco.2.9% use combustible cigarettes.

290K+ high school students nationwide currently USE COMBUSTIBLE CIGARETTES. ABOUT 90% of all adult smokers began smoking at or before age 18.
