Bill Tracking & Policy Priorities:

Bill Tracking:

- Nevada Legislature Personalized Legislative Tracking (PLT): PLT is a free service that allows you to subscribe to BDRs, bills, and budgets that are of interest to you and subsequently tag and create notes. You will also receive immediate notifications of hearings, a daily status notification, and have access to tailored, exportable reports.
- <u>Children's Bill Tracking List</u>: Nevada Institute for Children's Research and Policy Tracking list of bills related to children's health, education, safety, economic well-being and other categories.
- <u>Children's Advocacy Alliance 2025 Bill Tracker</u>: Bills relating to child safety, school readiness, economic well-being, and health.

- <u>Share Your Opinion on Legislative Bills:</u> A quick and easy way to share your opinions on bills with legislators. You must have a registered Nevada Legislature account.
- <u>View and participate in legislative meetings or hearings</u>. Find the session/meeting you want to view or participate in and then click on 'View Event' or 'View Event on YouTube'. Instructions for how to participate in person, or by phone can be found on the meeting agenda. You may also view meetings and floor sessions from the Nevada Legislature <u>YouTube channel</u>.
- <u>Submit Written Testimony to Committees</u>: Select the appropriate committee and then refer to the meeting agenda for specific details about where and when to send your written testimony.
